



Colgan Air, Inc. Flight 3407

Colgan Air, Inc.'s immediate focus is on the families of the passengers and the crew of Continental Connection flight 3407. The accident investigation is complex and ongoing, and we continue to cooperate with the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB). As we learn additional information, we will utilize this website (www.colganair.com) as our central source of communication with the news media and public.

Flight 3407 was operating from Newark Liberty International Airport to Buffalo Niagara International Airport when it was involved in an accident outside Buffalo Niagara Airport at about 10:20 PM EST Thursday, February 12. This flight was operated by Colgan Air.

The flight carried 44 passengers and a crew of four. There was also an off-duty Colgan Air crewmember aboard, bringing the number of individuals to 49.

Flight 3407 was operated using a Dash 8 Q400 aircraft. This aircraft was manufactured on April 12, 2008 and was placed into service by Colgan that month.
